#### GRADING


**Kiski's GPA formula is computed using a 100-point scale.** Teachers report percentage grades on a quarterly basis. Honors courses are weighted by adding 3% and advanced courses are weighted by adding 5%. Unweighted and weighted GPAs are computed at the end of each semester; both GPAs are available. Kiski does not rank. A Kiski GPA only includes courses taken at Kiski.
